Week 48 of 52 *Hebrew Words Every Christian Should Know* by Dave Adamson: “Chazaq” (khaw-zawk’) = *take heart.*” In the Old Testament, faith includes an aspect of acting upon that faith in courageous ways. New Testament believers know that we are not saved by our actions, but our belief. Similarly, our belief is followed by action that affirms our loyalty to the gospel message and the Great Commission. A key word from tomorrow’s sermon is “stand,” which might not seem like much activity at first. But I’m sure you have seen that sometimes, when the storms of life come your way, to stand firm and persevere in your faith is your first opportunity to “take heart.” ([John 16:33](#))
