<u>Sermon Notes:</u> "A Righteous Man" by Curt Deming, Teaching Pastor, <u>Luke 23:44-56</u> Old Testament Reading, <u>Psalm 31:1-5</u>; New Testament Reading, <u>Hebrews 10:19-25</u>.

This Part III in Luke 19:28-20:19 will cover these three topics:

A. Ministry in Jerusalem (Luke 19:28-21:28)

B. Passion (Luke 22:1-23:56) — FINISHING TODAY

Last Week "What Our Deeds Deserve" (Luke 23:26-43) Jesus could have saved Himself, but He offered Himself for us; Our salvation = an exchange of righteousness: The penalty for our sin was paid at the cross. The righteousness of Jesus is imputed to believers

A. Resurrection and Ascension (<u>Luke 24:1-53</u>) — In weeks to come

What we will learn this week:

- Jesus is humanity's only righteous man, and therefore, he is our perfect sacrifice. Theological term called "Substitutionary Atonement."
- Although it is not easy to believe in the resurrection, alternate theories of wha might have happened are even more implausible.

Consider the Jesus' last words from <u>Luke 23:46</u> and last week's Old Testament (OT) reading, <u>Psalm 22:1</u>, and compare it with today's OT reading <u>Psalm 31:1-5</u>.

Was Jesus just one (of many) righteous men? (Luke 23:47)

There have been three theories given for what happened to the body of Jesus to reject the supernatural resurrection. Can you identify the witness Luke provides that refute these theories? [*More witness testimony to come in the next chapter of Luke.*] (1) **Swoon theory** (Luke 23:47) What would a Roman centurion know of death?

- (2) Wrong tomb (<u>Luke 23:48-49</u>; <u>Luke 23:55-56</u>) Can you list some details about the tomb? [Outside the Bible, few women are noted much less contrasted favorable with the religious leaders.]
- (3) **Stolen by disciples to perpetuate the hoax** (<u>Luke 23:52-56</u>) [This theory was spread by the religious leaders.]

What do we know about the man who claimed the body of Jesus? (Luke 23:50-51)
