

<u>Sermon Notes:</u> "Truth has Perished: Jeremiah's Temple Sermon", by Curt Deming, Teaching Pastor, <u>Jeremiah 7:1-8:3</u>. Old Testament Readings: <u>II Kings 19:14-19</u> and <u>II Kings 19:32-36</u>; New Testament Reading: <u>Mark 11:15-19</u>.

Four Weeks Ago — "The Call of Jeremiah" Jeremiah 1:1-19.

- The call of God is more than an invitation.
- The Lord equips those he calls.

Three Weeks Ago — "Promiscuous Worship", Jeremiah 2:1-37.

- Everybody worships.
- There is only one true God who is worthy of our worship.
- Therefore, any alternative plan is doomed.

**Two Weeks Ago** — "A Tale of Two Sisters", by Curt Deming, Teaching Pastor, <u>Jeremiah 3:1-4:4</u>.

- The Lord restores the broken.
- ... But only the broken.

**Last Week** — Terror on Every Side", by Curt Deming, Teaching Pastor, <u>Jeremiah 4:5-6:30</u>.

New Testament Reading: Matthew 11:25-30; Old Testament Reading: Habakkuk 1:1-11.

- We are all "rejected silver."
- But the Lord offers "rest for your souls."
- Also, don't be stubborn.

### What will we learn?

- Rejection of God leads to separation from God.
- Religiosity is no substitute for loyalty and obedience.
- Also, don't be stubborn.

Where was Jeremiah to stand when the Lord commanded him to utter this prophecy? (Jeremiah 7:1-2)

What groups of people was he likely to come into conflict there?

There was a prevailing theology at that time about "the temple of the Lord". In what way was Jeremiah challenging this point-of-view or belief? (Jeremiah 7:2-10)

When Jesus 'cleansed the temple' during his final days in Jerusalem what phrase heard in Jeremiah did He use? (Jeremiah 7:11; Matthew 21:13, Mark 11:17, Luke 19:46)

The Lord pointed to evidence of His future action with regard to the temple, by referring to what had happened to Shiloh. What was the significance of the place, Shiloh? (Jeremiah 7:12-15)

Judah had worshiped a false goddess known by the epithet, "Queen of Heaven," possibly a nickname or title. What are some other names used for this female fertility goddess? (Jeremiah 7:16-25)

The Lord admonished them to change their ways, but did they listen? He now admonishes them to change their ways; will they listen? What has happened to the truth?

(Jeremiah 7:26-28)

What deeply evil thing was done during the worship at the place called Topheth (or Gehenna)? (Jeremiah 7:30-33)

Jeremiah predicts the destruction of the nation of Judah and the city of Jerusalem in horrifying detail. According to 8:3, what will the attitude of the survivors be? (Jeremiah 7:29-8:3)
