False gods are nothing at all. ٠ Stubbornness is a barrier to truth. The Lord delights in kindness justice and righteousness. Last Week—"Four Kinds of Destroyers", Jeremiah 11-20 We have a responsibility to believe what is true. Only the word of the Lord is trustworthy. The end is not the end. What will we learn this week? The Bible is rooted in history and geography. One day a righteous king will come to lead us. ♦ Until then, expect sowing and reaping.
