Sermon Notes: “Whom to Avoid?”, by Curt Deming, Teaching Pastor [II Thessalonians 3:1-18](#).

What will we learn?

- How should we discipline disobedience in a church setting?
- Who deserves such discipline?
- How should we pray for others?

Main ideas of both letters:

- Triune God works to accomplish our salvation.
- Believers are appointed to salvation rather than wrath.
- Thessalonian church is a model for others.
- Our hope is based upon the return of Jesus.

II Thessalonians setting:

- Timothy returned to Paul and Silas in Corinth with mixed news.
- The disruptive-idle in the church needed to be confronted.
- Some were confused about the timing of Christ’s return.
- They were facing increased persecution.

II Thessalonians outline:

- Chapter 1– Revelations
- Chapter 2 - Rebellion
- Chapter 3 - Responsibility.

II Thessalonians I

- Trials = opportunities to display our faith.
- Jesus will return as judge.
- We can trust God’s justice and goodness.
- Paul showed us how to pray in accordance with God’s purposes.

II Thessalonians 2

- The “Day of the Lord” (in OT and NT) = 2nd Coming of Jesus (NT)
- Before Jesus returns, the Man of Lawlessness (Antichrist) will attempt to deceive.
- All of the Trinity are involved in our salvation.
- Paul models kingdom-centered prayer.
