#### What we learned last week: (Matthew 9:1-17)

- Three stories of hostility towards Jesus.
- Four friends' faith results in more than expected.
- One is called and reports to duty.
- Three examples about fasting.

#### What will we learn? (Matthew 9:18-38)

- The faith of Jairus and his daughter.
- The faith of the woman and the cloak.
- The faith of the two blind men and the mute.
- The harvest then and now.

Matthew says that while Jesus sat and ate with the tax collectors and sinners, that both John's disciples and a leader of the local synagogue in Capernaum came to him. John's disciples and the leaders of the synagogue were part of the 2000 year Jewish religious culture. Jesus refers to old and new wineskins. Of the three groups of people mentioned above, who might be identified as old or new wineskins? (Matthew 9:16-19)

He performed miracles for so many, yet what did he asked his disciples to do? (Matthew 9:37-38)
