Sermon Notes: "A Kingdom in Turmoil" Esther 1, by Rick Krebs .

Old Testament Reading: Daniel 9:1-6.

New Testament Reading: Ephesians 5:21-24.

What we will learn this week:

- The story before the story.
- Reading through a Christian world view lens.
- The state is set, the lines are drawn.
- The application for us—today.

Who is the author of the book of **Esther**?

For a book of the Bible, who is not mentioned at all?

The Book of Esther begins with a story of the king of Persia and his queen. Since the Old Testament focuses on God's chosen nation. Why would this story be of any significance?

The period of the book of <u>Daniel</u> precedes the events of the book of <u>Esther</u>. What is the relationship between the events of the book of Daniel and Esther? What kingdom succeeded the Babylonian kingdom? (<u>Daniel 1:1</u>; <u>Daniel 5:30</u>; <u>Ezra 1</u>; <u>Nehemiah 1:1-2</u>; <u>Esther 1:1-3</u>)

The story begins with three elaborate days long banquets put on by the king of Persia. How many provinces encompassed his kingdom? (<u>Esther 1:1</u>)

In what state was the Xerces when he summoned Queen Vashti? (Esther 1:10)

What happened to Queen Vashti as a result? (Esther 1:19)

Setting the stage for later events in the book of Esther, what kind of personality does king Persian possess? (Esther 1:8; Esther 1:10; Esther 1:12b; Esther 1:13: Esther 1:18b)

What famous ruling resulted from the Queen's response to the king and the threat it posed to the princes and nobles of the kingdom? (<u>Esther 1:22</u>)
