

Sermon Notes: "Esther's Rise per God's Plan" Esther 2, by Rick Krebs .

Old Testament Reading: Proverbs 3:1-4.

New Testament Reading: Matthew 10:32-33.

What we will learned last week: (Esther 1)

- The story before the story.
- Reading through a Christian world view lens.
- The state is set, the lines are drawn.
- The application for us—today.

What we will learn this week:

- The King's plan and approach
- Esther's metamorphosis
- Mordecai's rise in prominence
- Reflection and application.

In Cinderella, the prince invited women to a ball. In this real-to-life story what did king Xerces agree to do to replace his prior Queen Vashti who displeased him by rejecting his command to show herself to his drunken friends? (<u>Esther 2:1-4</u>)

We are next introduced to the other main characters in this example of God's sovereignty, two Jews exiled from Jerusalem. What were there Jewish names? (<u>Esther 2:5-7</u>)

What was Esther's relationship to Mordecai? (Esther 2:7)

What was one of the characteristics that Esther possessed? (Esther 2:7)

What other character did Esther exhibit while in the harem of Xerces? (Esther 2:8-9)

Did Mordecai abandon Esther to her fate when she was taken into the king's harem? (<u>Esther</u> 2:10)

What was king Xerces' opinion of Esther and how did he respond? (Esther 2:17-18)

What other of Esther's character do we see in Esther 2:10 and Esther 2:19-20?

What is the Hebrew and Babylonian meaning of the name Mordecai? (see e.g., Mordecai)

What is the meaning of the name Hadassah or Esther? (see e.g., <u>Hadassah</u>; <u>Esther</u>)

The Bible is not just stories, but history. This verse provides a specific time, place, and a relationship to a well attested historical figure in history, <u>Xerces</u>, ruler of Persia.

Since Mordecai was in close proximity to Esther, he was in a position to overhear a conspiracy. What happened when Mordecai passed this information to Queen Esther. (Esther 2:21-22)
