Sermon Notes: "Whose Request Wins?," <u>Esther 5-6</u>, by Rick Krebs .

Old Testament Reading: Exodus 2:1-10.

New Testament Reading: Matthew 6:28-34.

What we will learned last week: (Esther 3-4)

- A rise of hatred, power, and pride.
- The plot, the agreement, but within God's providence.
- Mordecai and Esther collaborate, but work remains.

What we will learn this week: (Esther 5-6)

- Esther's cautious request tomorrow
- Haman's emotional tug-of-war
- King Xerces' sleepless night
- Haman's evil plan explodes.

Why was it important that king Xerces held out his scepter for Esther to touch? (Esther 5:1-2; Esther 4:11)

What was Haman's response and what prophetic word did his wife say just before he left for Esther's second banquet? (Esther 6:12-14)
