Last week: "The Upside Down Kingdom (Part 2)", Matthew 20:17-34, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor.
Old Testament Reading: Isaiah 53:1-6; New Testament Reading: Matthew 20:17-34

- Prediction of Suffering (Matthew 20:17-19)
- Prescription of Service (Matthew 20:20-28)
- Presentation by the Suffering Servant (Matthew 20:29-34)

This Week: "Veni, Vidit, Verat", Matthew 21:1-17, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor. Old Testament Reading: Psalm 8; New Testament Reading: John 7:37-44

Flow of the passage:

- Jesus enters Jerusalem, vv. 1-11
- Jesus enters the temple, v. 12
- Jesus "Cleans House", vv. 12-16
- Jesus clashes with leaders, vv. 14-16
- Jesus leaves, <u>v. 17</u>

In what conveyance did the Roman conquerors arrive for their triumphal entry into Rome?

When Jesus entered Jerusalem, what was he riding? What message does this convey?

How did the Jewish rabbis believe the Messiah would come?

However, what did their own scriptures say? (Matthew 21:4-5; Zechariah 9:9)

Jesus was born in Bethlehem. Why did the rabbis not know this fact? (Matthew 2:13-23)

What sentiment was the crowd exhibiting when "a very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches and spread them on the road?" (Matthew 21:8; Leviticus 23:39-41)

What does the word "Hosanna" mean? (Matthew 21:9; Hosanna)

The crowd passed the word throughout the whole city. Who did they think Jesus was? (Matthew 21:11)

Where did Jesus find the merchants and money changers?

Overturning the money changers tables was foreshadowed/foretold in the scriptures. What did it signify? (Matthew 21:12; ; Jeremiah 7:11; Isaiah 56:3-7; Jeremiah 19; Second Temple)

Who did Jesus heal at the temple? (Matthew 21:14)

Who might be disallowed in the temple area? Why might the leaders be indignant? (<u>Matthew</u> 21:15)

Why did the leaders call the people children and what were they implying Jesus was doing to them? (Matthew 21:16)

How did Jesus answer them? (Psalm 8:2)

By quoting scripture what was Jesus saying to the leaders?

Jesus left them for where? Why might he go there? (Matthew 21:17)
