

What did one witness finally come forward with a statement that was similar to what Jesus said earlier that was what the Sanhedrin was looking for? (John 2:18-21)

Would the high priest understand the claim Jesus was making? (Leviticus 21:10)

Was Peter's answer to the first servant girl an open and direct denial?

Was Peter's answer to the second servant's girl and those gathered outside a direct denial? With what did he add to guarantee his word?

A little later, what gave Peter away as probably one who had been with Jesus?

What did Peter invoke in this third and final denial?

What happened immediately after? (Luke 22:61; Matthew 26:74)

What did Peter then do? (Matthew 26:75; Hebrews 4:15-16)
