 - ⇒ By following Christ's example.

- (3) Do you find Paul's metaphor of Gospel citizenship to be a helpful image? If not, what is your favorite metaphor for what it means to be a Christian in the 21st century?

- (2) How does Paul's and Timothy's title set the tone for the entire letter?
