Old Testament Reading: Psalm 110; New Testament Reading: Hebrews 1:1-14

Key Points from Last Week:

- Hebrews 1:5-14 The Exposition
- Parallel Structure with the Exordium **Hebrews 1:1-**4
- Many Old Testament quotations to make clear that Jesus:
 - ♦ Is the Royal Son of God surpassing the angels who must serve *Him*.
 - ♦ "Son of God" in the Bible
 - Firstborn of God
 - ♦ The unchanging Son of God, outranking the transient angels.
- **Jesus** is superior to the angels in His **being**, **rank**, and **revelation**.

Breakdown of the First Main Point of Hebrews:

- Exordium Hebrews 1:1-4
- Exposition Hebrews 1:5-14
- Exhortation Hebrews 2:1-4

Why was the imperative given to the Hebrew Christians? (<u>Hebrews 2:1</u>; <u>Hebrews 1</u>)

What exhortation of Moses would be brought to remembrance of the Hebrew Christians? (<u>Deuteronomy 4:9a</u>)

What lack of discipline would lead to a drifting away from the revelation of Messiah Yeshua?

Who had spoken to the prophets to bring the message of God's requirements? (Acts 7:38, 53)

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The word "binding" indicates a legal covenant to which the Jews must adhere. What is the author of Hebrews telling the Hebrew Christians about the gravity of the message/revelation of Jesus? (Numbers 15:30-31; 1 Corinthians 10:1-12)

The author of Hebrews in no uncertain terms states that disobeying the gospel message brings a penalty worse than disobeying the Torah.

By what means did God use to announce the gospel of salvation? (<u>Luke 1:1-2</u>; <u>2 Peter 1:16</u>; <u>1 John 1:1</u>)

God also confirmed this gospel by what other means? (Acts 4:29-31)

The certainty of the message of salvation guarantees the consequence for not taking it seriously.

Now, ask yourself, "Am I drifting?"
