

Last Week: ""Attention: Drift May be Occurring," <u>Hebrews 2:1-4</u>, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor Old Testament Reading: <u>Deuteronomy 30:11-18</u>; New Testament Reading: <u>2 Peter 2:17-21</u>

Neglecting God's salvation results in missing it altogether leading to inescapable judgement.

The certainty of the message of salvation guarantees the consequence for not taking it seriously. Ask yourself, "Am I drifting?"

This Week: "The Son's Solidarity with Humanity," <u>Hebrews 2:5-9</u>, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor Old Testament Reading: <u>Psalm 8</u>; New Testament Reading: <u>Romans 5:12-17</u>

What is solidarity?

What does it mean that God Son chose solidarity humanity?

- Jesus' superiority over angels <u>Hebrews 1:5-14</u>
 - ♦ Warning against drift <u>Hebrews 2:1-4</u>
- Jesus' solidarity with people <u>Hebrews 2:5-9</u>

To whom did God give the earth to rule over? (Genesis 1:26-28)

Who appears to rule the earth (or earthly domain) today? (<u>Deuteronomy 32:8, ESV</u>; <u>Daniel</u> <u>10:20b, 21b</u>)

What will humanity's position in the age to come? (1 Corinthians 6:2a, 3a; Psalm 8:4-6)

Who will rule over the new heaven, new earth, and all of creation?

Does it appear that this is the situation now on the earth today? (Romans 8:20-21)

What has been the result of humanity's attempt to usurp rulership of itself?

What has Jesus achieved by taking on the human form (really) and suffered death in our place? (Hebrews 2:9; Philippians 2:6-11; 2 Corinthians 5:14b-15, 21)

Jesus did not just take the form of a man then ascended into heaven, instead why did he die? (Revelation 6:9b)

What is the consequence of his suffering death, rising from the dead, and then ascending into heaven? (Revelation 5:10)

It is a mystery that the humble Son of Man, a little lower than the angels, is crowned by God with glory and honor above all else.

Jesus fulfills God's true design for humanity and renews our partnership with God as corulers under God.

Have you become convinced of Jesus' solidarity with you?
