

Was Jesus tempted to sin having found himself in human form? Did Jesus ever sin?

The high priest not only made a sacrifice for the sin of the people, but also for his own sin. How is Jesus' office of high priest higher than that of the Old Testament high priest?

As a human being, did Jesus want to die?

When we then approach God, what do we know we will receive from him?

Who selected the high priest under the law given to Moses? (Exodus 28:1; Hebrews 5:1-10; Psalm 110:4)

Our confidence in Jesus' compassion is reinforced by his humility. (<u>Mathew 26:36-38</u>; <u>Luke</u> <u>22:41-44</u>)

Jesus not only gets us, He's got us.
