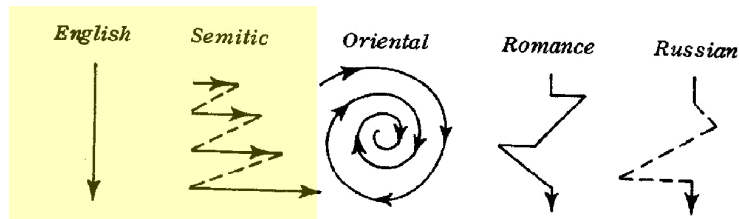

As a human being, did Jesus want to die?

When we then approach God, what do we know we will receive from him?

Who selected the high priest under the law given to Moses? ([Exodus 28:1](#); [Hebrews 5:1-10](#); [Psalm 110:4](#))

Our confidence in Jesus’ compassion is reinforced by his humility. ([Mathew 26:36-38](#); [Luke 22:41-44](#))

**Jesus not only gets us, He’s got us.**
