- In contrast, God has promised by oath apart from Torah that another priest of another priesthood would supersede the old arrangement
 - That priest would be God's Son—a king-priest—who being perfect, and perfectly qualified for the job, would be the perfect sacrifice to bring God's people to their own perfect completeness forever
