Old Testament Reading: <u>Genesis 50:15-21</u>; New Testament Reading: <u>1 Corinthians</u> <u>12:12-26</u>

Ask yourself, "How am I encouraging growth in the body of Christ?" (<u>Ephesians</u> <u>4:1-6</u>)

- Regardless of who we were before, all believers are part of one body
- When life gives you lemons, ask God for wisdom

This Week: "Out with the Old. In with the New," <u>Hebrews 8:1-13</u>, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor

Old Testament Reading: Jeremiah 31:31-34 ;

New Testament Reading: Hebrews 8:1-13

Torah – the old covenant enacted under *Moses*—set up the arrangement of the **Levitical priesthood**:

A priesthood founded on bloodline relations and mere *humans* who were weak/born in sin and do all sin

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In contrast, God has promised by oath apart from Torah that another priest of another priesthood would supersede the old arrangement :

 That priest would be God's Son—a king-priest—who being perfect, and perfectly qualified for the job, would be the perfect sacrifice to bring God's people to their own perfect completeness forever

The (high) priest an imperfect mediator between God and man in the tabernacle made by man, offering a sacrificial blood offering for himself and the people.

What is the atoning gift and/or sacrifice Jesus, our eternal High Priest, offered?

The inner sanctuary, the Holiest Place of the tabernacle or temple, was a shadow of what other place?

How many and who has the made the sacrifice necessary to enter the Holy Place in heaven?

(1 Timothy 2:5)

Why was there a need for God to promise a new and better covenant? (Hebrews 8:7-9; Hosea 8:1; Jeremiah 31:31-34)

What are the key elements in the new covenant and the ability for it to be kept by the parties? (<u>Hebrews 8:10-11</u>)

Why will the believer be able to approach God given that sin cannot be in the presence of God? (<u>Hebrews 8:12</u>)

What then is the status of the old Mosaic covenant? (Hebrews 8:13)
