This Week: “Hall of Faith: *Part 4.0*” [Hebrews 11:32-40](#) by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor.

Old Testament Reading: [Psalm 37:5-9](#); New Testament Reading: [Hebrews 11:32-40](#)

- ◇ Overcoming Opposition, [Hebrews 11:32-35a](#)
 - ⇒ Faith *accomplishes more* than we can imagine in this life
 - ◆ Gideon to Jephthah part of the book of **Judges**
 - ◇ **Barak: Judges 4-5**
 - * Led the Israelites in victory against a confederation of enemy states enforced by 900 iron-chariots
 - ◇ **Gideon: Judges 6-8**
 - * 32,000 man army reduced to 300 and defeated the enemy military without lifting a sword - a strategy of confusion and diversion Barak: **Judges 4-5**
 - ◇ **Jephthah: Judges 11-12**
 - * A great warrior who had confidence that God would lead his people as He did in Egypt through a regional dispute with Israel’s enemies and was victorious
 - ◇ **Samson: Judges 13-16**
 - * Hebrew strong man who overpowered the enemies of Israel and in faith, depended on God, giving up his life to fulfill his purpose
 - ◆ David, Samuel, and the prophets
 - ◇ **Samuel: 1 Samuel 15—1 Kings 2**
 - * The last of the judges and first of the prophetic guild best known for installing the first kings of Israel and by faith seeking God’s intervention at a major battle giving Israel victory
 - ◇ **David: 1 Samuel 16-1 Kings 2**
 - * Second King of Israel but God’s first choice who was a man after God’s own heart
- ◇ Suffering & Death, [Hebrews 11:35b-38](#)
 - ⇒ Faith sustains the suffering, **Romans 8:17, 35-37**
- **The Importance of Faith, [Hebrews 11:39-40](#)**
 - ⇒ Faith *holds together* all the people of God, **Ephesians 4:1b-6**.
