What is "Therefore" there for? (Hebrews 12:1)

The words are to invoke for the this Jewish community, a metaphor for the life in Christ:

- the Graeco-Roman athlete the individual Christian,
- arena

- the heavenly realm,

• and spectators

the host of the faithful,
e.g., those identified in <u>Hebrews 11</u>.
