- <sup>18</sup> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Romans 12:18 (NIV) (see also from the Beatitudes— Matthew 5:8-9)
- "See to it that no one fall short ... no bitter root grows up ..." <u>Hebrews 12:12</u> (NIV) (c.f. <u>Deuteronomy 29:16-21; 1 Timothy 4:16</u>)
- Don't fixate on or be tricked into satisfying the immediate desire(s) of the flesh in exchange for the inheritance of the life eternal. (Genesis 25:29-34; Philippians 3:19)

**This Week:** "Final Warnings: Part 2," <u>Hebrews 12:18-29</u>, by Brandon Harris, Teaching Pastor Old Testament Reading: <u>Deuteronomy 4:9-24</u>; New Testament Reading: <u>Hebrews 12:18-29</u>

- The writer brings the scene well known to the Jews how God visited them on Mount Sinai—how threatening a sight and how unbearable the sound of his voice. A truly physical yet fearful it was to be in the presence of the Holy God when they were not holy. (Exodus 19:10-13, 16-19)
- But the situation has now changed. Faith in God has brought you to Mount Zion, God's city, the heavenly Jerusalem the place where God will dwell with (the new) man. (Revelation 21:1-5)
- The Christion now belongs to this city which we look forward where:
  - ♦ God dwells
  - ♦ God's heavenly host legions of angles with shouts of joy
  - Church of the firstborn Jesus Christ and the assembly of saints with him whose names are written in the lambs book of life. (<u>Luke 10:20</u>; <u>Revelation 3:5,13:8, 20:12, & 21:27</u>)
- God is the judge of all and Jesus the mediator of a new covenant because of the blood that was shed for our redemption.

- "See to it that ..." <u>Hebrews 12:25a</u>) (NIV) another command, from Jesus Christ. We can't take it lightly.
- Once more the earth will be shaken, not only the earth, but the heaven also. (Haggai 2:6)
- Then Jesus and his saints will receive a kingdom that cannot be shaken (everlasting).
- We should be thankful for God's work of redemption and worship Him only lest we forget that "God is a consuming fire." (<u>Deuteronomy 4:24</u>; <u>Isaiah 33:14</u>)
