1st Bible Reading: Luke 24:1-12; 2nd Bible Reading: John 20:19-20

Gospel = Good News

- ♦ The Good News is what we receive (not invent), stand upon, and are saved so long as we continue to hold onto it with all our hearts. (Romans 1:16a)
- ♦ The message is a historical claim—these things happened in real time and space.
- ♦ The resurrection was not a private event, nor was it a spiritual event. Jesus Christ bodily returned to life—a new life—and appeared to eye witnesses: the twelve apostles and 500 people at one time.
- Christ's resurrection is essential to the gospel.
 - Christ died for our sins.
 - Christ's message that through him we can have peace with God.
 - Without the hope of the resurrection our Christian faith is useless and empty of any power.
- Christ's resurrection is essential to the faith
 - ♦ If Jesus did not rise from the dead, then the writer, Paul, the twelve apostles, and the 500 witnesses, including the skeptic James were all liars.
 - ♦ If the resurrection of Christ is removed then the power to bring forgiveness of sin(s), peace with God, and inner transformation, its all a sham.
 - ♦ "If the dead are not raised, 'Let us eat and drink today, for tomorrow we die." (v. 32b)
- Christ's resurrection is essential to ours.
- *Christ's resurrection* is essential to *hope*.
