♦ One of three 'wisdom books' : Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, along with two other books of poetry,: Psalms and Song of Solomon.

## • Proverbs in Salvation History

Written first in King Solomon's day (<u>1 Kings 4:29-33</u>), David's son, and later edited during Hezekiah's day some 200 years later.

## Reading Proverbs

- Proverbs provides wisdom for moral living. Laws of the physical—forces, mass, and motion.
- Cause and effect of moral choices and actions.
- Wisdom—knowledge applied (<u>Exodus 31:1-3</u>)
- ♦ Foundation of true wisdom if "the fear of Yahweh God"—the LORD.
- ♦ Includes for poems of lady wisdom calling the simple-minded and naïve to learn from her.
- ♦ To live by these words provides probable outcomes, but not promises (no guarantees.)

## Christ in Proverbs

- ♦ Paul equates the wisdom of God with Christ (1 Corinthians 1:22-24)
- Christ is identified as the eternal Word of God through whom all things were made and by whom all things exist and have their being.
- ♦ John 1: 1-5 and Colossians 2:2-3

Christ is the perfect embodiment of wisdom who exemplifies the perfect, wise life.
